School Contributions and Charges

Under the School Education Act 1999 there is a requirement for schools to outline ahead all contributions and charges that the education of the children will incur.

The contributions and charges can be broken into five sections:

1. Contributions.
2. Charges for extra cost optional items.
3. Items for personal use in the educational program.
4. Other fund raising costs.
5. Optional costs for non-educational activities.

1. Contributions

\$ 30 per child with a maximum of \$60 per family.

A contribution is voluntary. Funds collected are used towards the cost of materials, services and facilities used by students in the education program. Contributions collected at this school contribute to:

- Reading resources & materials – Diana Rigg, Talk for Writing
- Maths resource & materials – Ninja Maths
- STEM resources & materials – Coding Club, Robotics
- Data hub, PATS testing
- Library books
- Physical Education resources & materials – Sport equipment, before school sport, carnivals
- Art resources & materials – Art Club, Kelmscott Show
- LOTE resources & materials - Indonesian
- Photocopying Supplementary

2. Charges for extra cost optional items

Charges refer to the provision of extra cost activities which is part of an education program and which the contributions do not cover. These amounts can vary from year to year. **Students would only incur costs when they are involved in the particular activity.** The amounts indicated would be the **maximum** for that activity. If a particular event does not occur within the school year **NO** charges for that event would apply. The School Board has approved all charges.
