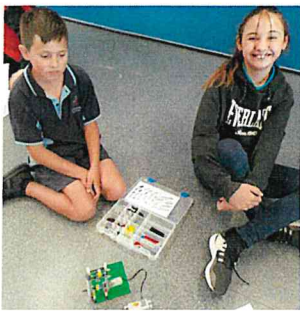

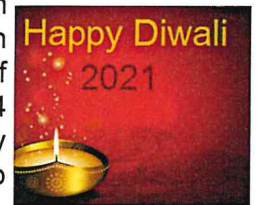

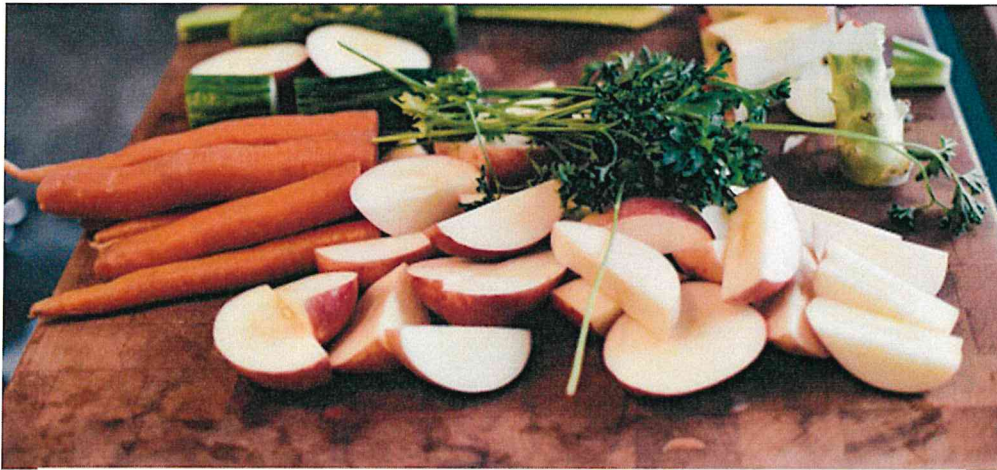


2022 PLANNING
